Read Exodus 34:6-7 and Lamentations 3:22-24

1. Reflecting on the Sermon:

6. Mother Teresa's Quote:

7. Encouraging Others:

- Share a story of someone in your life who has been faithful to you. How did their faithfulness impact you, and how can you encourage others through your faithfulness?

8. Application Challenge:

- What will you take away from this study and discussion and what difference might it make in your life?
